Dear Mr. Perry:

This letter serves as official notification that Bio Green is a participant in the US Department of Agriculture's (USDA) BioPreferredSM program.

BioPreferred is a Federally-managed program that aims to increase the purchase and use of renewable, sustainable biobased products. Biobased products are defined by USDA as products that are composed in whole or in large part of domestic agricultural or forestry materials. Biobased products can include plant, animal, and marine materials. BioPreferred works with manufacturers such as Bio Green, distributors, and large-scale buyers (e.g. the government and the commercial markets) to increase awareness, purchase, and use of biobased products.

Bio Green manufactures Bio Green Plant Food and BioGreenAg (BGAG). These products are identified by USDA as "BioPreferred" or "BioPreferred-designated items." You may also identify your products this way and promote them as such. The products above are identified within BioPreferred's "fertilizer" category -- products formulated or processed to provide nutrients for plant growth and/or beneficial bacteria to convert nutrients into plant usable forms. Biobased fertilizers consist mostly of biobased components, may include both biobased and chemical components, and must contain biobased content equal to or greater than 71%.

One major way USDA shares information about the BioPreferred designated items is via a list of the products on our website. Please visit www.biopreferred.gov and click on the link for the "Catalog" to view the entries for your designated items. Only biobased products that meet or exceed the minimum content established by USDA can be called "BioPreferred" and listed in this catalog.

Various government mandates, policies, and Presidential Executive Orders exist for the Federal Government agencies and Military branches to give preferred purchasing preference for BioPreferred biobased products. Over the coming years, we look forward to working with you to translate government greening policy into practice and to creating lasting environmental change for generations to come.
